DINNER AT THE CLUB


There will be a Dinner At The Club and a guest speaker on Wednesday, November 9 at 5:30 and on Saturday, November 19 at 5:30.

JIM PARKER BREAKS ALL TIME NATIONAL RECORD

Congratulations to our own Jimmy Parker, world-renowned tennis legend, USPTA Master Professional, and Pro Emeritus, on recently breaking the record of retired professional tennis player Bob Sherman for most National Championships by a man. According to the history tracking www.supersenior.info website, Sherman and Parker were tied with an all-time high of 125 USTA National Championships in the Men's category. The record breaking milestone came when Parker won the finals of the National Men's 70 Clay Court Championships on October 2nd.

After recovering from major knee surgery, Jimmy tied the record earlier this year by winning the Super Senior Father Son National Championships with his son Christopher. He tried unsuccessfully to break the record at the 70 and over National Grass court event. but finally broke through when he and Ken Robinson defeated Dean Corley and Michael Stewart, from California in the Clay Court doubles final. Parker and Robinson were on serve late in the third set when they found themselves down love 40 on Jimmy's serve.
