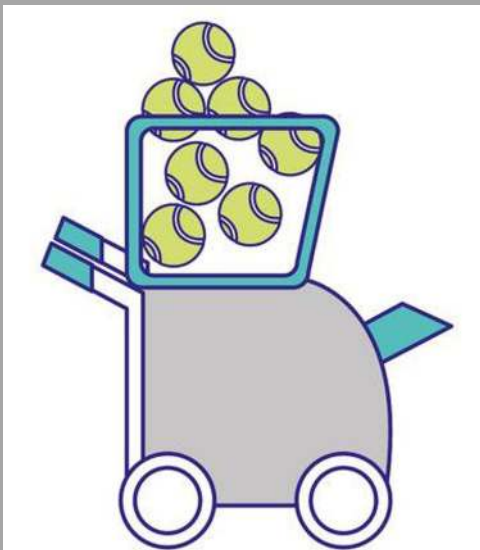

# **BUBBLE BLOCK TIME**

**It is starting to get chilly which means it is time for the bubble!**

**Bubble block time starts November 10th!**

**You can reserve the bubble for a 6 week block. (Unavailable from 12/22 - 1/6)**

## **BUBBLE RULE REMINDERS**

- Club members must cancel bubble reservations 24 hours before their scheduled time, or they will be billed for the court.**
- Players may not enter the bubble prior to their scheduled time, if there is a game in progress.**
- Players must exit the bubble promptly at the end of their scheduled time, to allow the next group of players to take the court. Lingering players may be billed a minimum extra 15 minutes if they cut into another group's reservation.**
